## Archaeology of Interregional Interaction 區域互動的考古學研究

### 課程大綱與閱讀書目

主旨：考古學由於時間與空間深度的特性，除了探討人類行為與個別遺址以外，可以透過考古材料，進行跨區域與跨時代社會互動的研究。本課程將針對區域及區域間的層次，探討考古學如何論證區域之間的互動關係。本課程第一部份集中討論區域考古研究的相關理論，第二部分則依據不同地理區域考古，選擇相關主題，進行深入探討。涵蓋的內容包括互動圈、世界體系理論、中心與邊緣，地理區域包括歐亞大陸、北美、中美、南美，以及非洲等地。

#### 評分標準：

評分方式分課堂口頭報告、課堂參與、與書面報告。書面報告包括每週閱讀心得，書目摘要，及期末報告。評分方式與標準如下，但亦將視選課情形調整。

口頭報告依選課人數分配，輪流帶領每週閱讀書目的介紹與討論；課堂參與為課堂的發言與討論。

以上佔學期成績 20%。

每週閱讀心得篇幅 2 頁，形式不限，應包含簡單內容摘要與讀後心得，必須於該週上課前以 email 繳交。遲交不予計分。(20%)

書目摘要由學生於學期開始後，就期末報告內容，選擇一地理區域與時代（如 American Southwest、Maya、Harappa、Mesopotamia 等），收集 15 篇該地區相關研究文獻資料（需為課堂閱讀書目以外），並於每則書目中撰寫一至二段的摘要。書目摘要統一使用 Endnote 或其他制式書目軟體格式，並於學期末繳交彙整，分發給選課同學。(10%)

期末報告 10-15 頁（不含書目）。報告題目需在期中考前確定，並需經授課老師同意。第 16 週進行期末報告的口頭報告。書面報告於學期最後一天繳交。(50%)  
以上佔學期成績 80%。
