課程目標	This course examines key issues in contemporary Chinese politics during the Reform Era (1978 to present). While the course's main focus is to explore China's domestic political and economic development, it will also discusses issues related to China's rise in the international system and her relations with several international organizations.			
課程概述	The course is divided into three sections. First, we will discuss the general background of China's political system and its evolution. Second, we will outline the path of China's transition from a socialist economy to a market-oriented structure. In the final section, we will begin to cover the issue of China's foreign relations, and explore the various impacts of China's rise on the international system.
