Tests and Quizzes. Vocabulary dictations are arranged once a week and quizzes are arranged after finishing a chapter. All students are expected to take tests and quizzes as they are scheduled. No make-up test or quiz is allowed. The score will be marked zero if you are unable to take the exam at the scheduled time, unless given official leave. Among eight vocabulary dictations and quizzes in this semester, only five grades will be recorded, meaning you have three free absences or three lowest grades will be dropped.
