	This course examines economic development in less-developed nations, with a focus on post-World-War-II development in African and East Asian countries. Throughout the quarter we will study many possible determinants of economic growth and development including foreign investment, international trade, and education. We will also examine various strategies governments have employed to promote growth such as import-substitution industrialization and export-led growth.	
課程概述 Course Description	As we compare and contrast the economic evolutions of individual countries, particular attention will be paid to the role that institutional factors such as corruption and executive power play in determining economic outcomes. We will also closely examine the influence of international organizations and foreign aid on economic outcomes in developing countries, with a focus on how institutional quality differences often determine the effectiveness of aid. We will conclude by	
	studying how economic growth is affecting environmental issues, and we will closely examine the political economy of how governments in developing countries are being affected by and responding to environmental challenges.
